

Getting married in a Church ceremony in Thailand



In our community in Thailand, a church marriage ceremony is possible, conducted by an ordained pastor of the German-speaking Protestant Congregation in Thailand. These ceremonies are recorded in the church registry and are recognized as valid Protestant Church Weddings.

There are two requirements for a church wedding in our community in Thailand:

1. Proof of a civil marriage, irrespective of whether it took place in Germany, Switzerland, Austria, or another country.
2. At least one spouse must belong to a Christian church (baptized) or have an internal connection to the Christian faith.

Upon request, I am able to conduct the Christian wedding ceremony in English. It's entirely possible to incorporate traditions from other religions and cultures of the non-Christian partner into the ceremony.

For non-members of our community, there is a compensation of THB 10,000 per day for conducting the ceremony. Additionally, we expect the travel and accommodation expenses for the pastor to be covered.

Whether you reside in Thailand or come from another country and are considering celebrating your wedding or a marital milestone such as a silver or golden anniversary with a church blessing in Thailand, we welcome your inquiry!
